STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Designating Kennebassis Road in Indian Township, Washington County, as a State Road.

Kennebassis Road, Indian Township; designated. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation be authorized and directed to designate Kennebassis Road, Indian Township, Washington County, leading easterly from U. S. Route 1 at Princeton as a state highway.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this legislation to provide citizens and taxpayers living on Kennebassis Road with state highway services which they have never been able to receive despite repeated requests since 1953 because this road was not included in the Act which incorporated the roads and highways of Indian Township into the State Highway System.
