STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Regulating the Merger of New Financial Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 9, § 233, additional. Title 9 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 233, to read as follows:

§ 233. Merger

No financial institution, credit union, federal credit union, national bank or bank holding company or its subsidiaries shall sell to or in any way merge with or become acquired by any other financial institution, credit union, federal credit union, national bank, or bank holding company or its subsidiaries within 5 years of the date it commences operation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent the acquisition or merger of new banking institutions for the first 5 years of their operation.
