STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing Additional Service Credit under the State Retirement System for Kenneth Newcomb.

Kenneth Newcomb; additional service credit. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Maine State Retirement System is directed to credit Kenneth Newcomb with $2\frac{2}{3}$ years of state service, provided that he remit to the system an amount equal to that contribution which should have been deducted from his compensation; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$3,496 payable to the Maine State Retirement System to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Kenneth Newcomb was employed 4 months of the year for 9 years, from 1945 through 1953 and received credit for only 4 months. He was not carried on the payroll but was considered as a contractor because he used his own mowing machine mowing rights-of-way.
