AN ACT Relating to Keeping of Records on Use of County-owned Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 8, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 8, to read as follows:

§ 8. Records of vehicles

For each vehicle owned or operated by the several counties of the State, records must be kept which will indicate the date, the driver, the destination, the mileage to and from such destination and the reason for such use. The records of each county department shall be submitted to the county commissioners for their inspection at their monthly meetings.

The use of any county vehicle for other than county business shall result in the charge of 20¢ per mile to the person so operating.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This legislation is intended to reduce the amount of personal use of public-owned vehicles by providing a constant check on the use of public-owned vehicles of the several counties.
