STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Establishing Privilege to Refuse Disclosure in a Patient-Psychiatrist Relationship.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 16, & 60, additional. Title 16 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 60, to read as follows:

§ 60. Psychiatrist and patient

A person has a privilege to refuse to disclose, and prevent a witness from disclosing, a communication between himself and a pychiatrist, if he claims the privilege.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The proposed Act will provide the same immunity to the patient-psychiatrist relationship that already exists for psychologists and pychological examiners.
