COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 888, L.D. 1173, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing State Aid for the Construction of Highways."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th line (5th line of L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "4" and insert in place thereof the underlined figure '3'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Fiscal Note the following:

'Sec. 2. Allocation. There is allocated from the income of the General Highway Fund the sum of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975, to carry out the purpose of this Act. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall be carried forward for the same purpose.

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this Act shall become effective July 1, 1974.'

Fiscal Note

It is estimated that the additional cost to the General Highway Fund would amount to approximately \$150,000 per year.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the utilization of 3 unit state aid money for the construction of unimproved state aid roads. At the present time, the law restricts utilization of state aid funds to no more than 2 unit money for construction activities.
