HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 890, L. D. 1177, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Vacation and Sick Leave Pay for County
Employees."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT Relating
to Vacation Pay for County Employees and Sick Leave Pay for
County Employees of Cumberland County.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
3 lines before the Statement of Fact (same in L.D.) and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Upon retirement, unused sick leave shall be paid to the county
employees of Cumberland County as follows: Up to 15 days'
pay after at least 10 years of service and up to 20 days' pay
after at least 20 years of service.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for sick leave
pay to be paid only to the county employees of Cumberland County.
