AN ACT Adding Another Dealer to Board of Hearing Aid Dealers and Fitters

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 1659-A, sub-§ 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection 2 of section 1659-A of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 320 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

The board shall consist of 3 4 hearing aid dealers and fitters, one physician and one osteopath.
