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**AN ACT** Relating to Zoning Certain Throughways as Commercial.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 30, § 4962, sub-§ 1, ¶ C-1, additional.** Subsection 1 of section 4962 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 455 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding a new paragraph C-1, to read as follows:

**C-1.** Property abutting a highway in a municipality designated a "throughway" by the Department of Transportation and upon which commercial vehicles are permitted, must be zoned commercial, the depth to be determined by the planning board or the board of appeals, or both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to zone "throughways" for commercial use.
