COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A "H.P. 897, L.D. 1184, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Inclusion of Odomoter Reading on Certificate of Registration of Motor Vehicles Returned Upon Transfer of Ownership."

Amenā said bill by inserting the following new sentence at the end of the last paragraph before the statement of fact:

'Upon surrender of the registration form to the Motor Vehicle Division of the Secretary of State, the Secretary of State shall not issue a new registration unless the information required by Title 17, section 1609-A has been completed on the surrendered registration form.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to provide that for a new registration of a motor vehicle, after surrender of registration, the information required by Title 17, section 1609-A shall be completed on the surrendered registration form.
