STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Pay for One Hundred Percent of Health Insurance for Retired Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1129, additional. Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1129, to read as follows:

§ 1129. Retired teachers

Subject to section 1121, retired teachers shall be provided health insurance equal to the single subscriber's share.

Sec. 2. Payment by State. The State of Maine, through the Board of Trustees of the Maine State Retirement System, shall pay 100% of the retired teachers' health insurance cost.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$455,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

As the State of Maine is providing health insurance for retired state employees, this bill seeks the same benefits for retired teachers.
