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**AN ACT** Providing for a Closed Season on Shrimp.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, c. 417, sub-c. II, Article 5-A, additional. Subchapter II of chapter 417 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new Article 5-A to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5-A. SHRIMPS**

**§ 4061. Season**

It is unlawful for any person to land, transport, buy, sell or process live, whole northern shrimp (*Pandalus borealis*) from May 1st to October 1st of each year.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title and is to conserve the shrimp resource.
