COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 904, L.D. 1192, Bill, "AN ACT Declaring Maine's Sovereignty for 200 miles Seaward from its Boundaries."

Amend said Bill by inserting in the 3rd line after the amending clause (same in L.D.) after the figure and word "200 miles" the following underlined words: 'or to the furthest edge of the Continental Shelf, whichever is greater,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th line after the enacting clause (5th and 6th lines in L.D.) the following underlined words: "and shall be issued at their discretion"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add "the furthest edge of the Continental Shelf" to the bill and to delete the discretion of the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries.
