STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Declaring Maine's Sovereignty for 200 Miles Seaward from its Boundaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 1, § 2, sub-§ 2-A, additional. Section 2 of Title 1 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 2-A, to read as follows:

2-A. —harvesting. The State of Maine declares that it owns and shall control the harvesting of the living resources of the seas adjoining the coast-line for a distance of 200 miles subject only to the boundary with Canada. Control over the harvesting of these living resources shall be by licenses or permits issued by the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries and shall be issued at their discretion;
