## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

#### AN ACT to Increase Salaries of County Officers for the County of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 11th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Penobscot County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

**Penobscot County:** County commissioners, \$3,399 \$4,500; chairman, \$3,559 \$6,000; clerk of courts, \$7,699 \$8,600; deputy clerk of courts, \$6,599 \$7,500; county attorney, \$8,999 \$10,000; first assistant county attorney, \$6,999 \$7,500; second assistant county attorney, \$6,999 \$7,500; county treasurer, \$4,399 \$5,500; sheriff, \$7,599 \$10,000; register of deeds, \$7,999 \$8,000; judge of probate, \$8,999 \$10,000; register of probate, \$6,599 \$7,200;

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$8,750 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975 to carry out the purpose of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
