COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 400, L.D. 1205, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Maine Students with Benefits of Environmental
Education."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line (4th and
5th line of L.D.) after the amending clause in section 1, the
underlined words "elementary and secondary"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
underlined sentence of section 1 and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'The responsibilities of the Director of Environmental Education
shall be those outlined in the state plan for environmental edu-
cation.'
