COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 405, L.D. 1207, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Displaying of Fireworks at Blue Hill Fair Grounds on Sunday."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following new Title: 'AN ACT Relating to Displaying of Fireworks on Sunday.'

Further amend said Bill in the 19th line (16th line of L.D.) by striking out the underlined words ", at the Blue Hill Fair Grounds"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the supervised display of fireworks at any place in the State.
