HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 405, L. D. 1207, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Displaying of Fireworks at Blue Hill Fair Grounds on Sunday."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, several Maine communities are having anniversary celebrations this summer and it is essential that such communities be permitted to display fireworks on Sunday; and

Whereas, the following legislation is necessary to permit such displays this coming summer; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
