COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to S.P. 409, L.D. 1211, Bill,  
"AN ACT Providing for Motor Vehicle Operator's License Classifi-  
cation."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 2  
before that part designated "Sec. 2. Appropriation." the  
following underlined paragraph:

'Any applicant who has made application for a "Class 1" or  
"Class 2" license and provides the Secretary of State with satis-  
factory evidence that an immediate examination is needed for  
employment purposes shall be examined as provided in this  
section within 7 days of such notification.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the beginning  
of the last paragraph before the Statement of Fact (same in  
L.D.) the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 2." and  
inserting in place thereof the following: 'Sec. 3.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to guarantee a prompt  
appointment for examination in case of need.
