COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 398, L. D. 1212, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Suspensions of Domestic Corporations by the
Secretary of State."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. R. S., T. 13-A, § 1301, sub-§ 5, amended. The last sentence of subsection 5 of section 1301 of Title 13-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 439 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

A certificate executed and filed as provided in sections 104 and 106 setting forth that a shareholders' meeting was held, the date and location of same, and that a majority of the shareholders voted to resume transacting business shall authorize such corporation to transact business; and after such certificate is filed, it shall be required to file annual reports and-pay annual-franchise-taxes.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 5 to 8 to be sections 6 to 9.

## Statement of Fact

The requirement of state franchise tax has been repealed by this Legislature. This amendment takes out reference to payment of taxes no longer required.
