AN ACT Relating to **Withdrawal from Participation in the Cumberland
County Recreation Center.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1971, C. 86, § 8-A, additional. Chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1971 is amended by adding a new section 8-A to read as follows:

Sec. 8-A. **Withdrawal.** Within one year after approval by a majority of the voters of Cumberland County of this Act, those communities that voted against approval may withdraw from participation therein and be relieved of their proportional share of county taxes by vote of a majority of the legal voters of such municipality voting at a special election duly called and held for the purpose in the same manner as the election relating to the approval of this Act.

Any participating municipality may call and hold more than one election under this Act during the above-defined withdrawal period and if any municipality does so, the result of its last election shall be governing.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit communities who voted against participation in the Cumberland County Recreation Center to be relieved of their proportional share of the county tax.
