STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Permanent Motor Vehicle Operators License Numbers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 539-A, amended. Section 539-A of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 10-A of chapter 245 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

§ 539-A. Permanent license number

The Secretary of State may shall require the submission of an applicant's social security number, when making application for an original or renewal operator's license, for the purpose of establishing a permanent number to be assigned to the operator's license.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 540, amended. The first sentence of section 540 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Each license shall state the name, age, place of residence of the licensee and the distinguishing numbers or marks the permanent number assigned to him and may contain a brief description of the licensee for the purpose of identification and such other information as the said Secretary of State shall deem necessary.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill requires that the social security number of an applicant for a motor vehicle operator's license be established as the permanent identifying number of the license.
