AN ACT Relating to a Bounty on Unlicensed Dogs in Area Frequented by Deer.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2901, amended.** The first sentence of section 2901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

There shall be a bounty of \$15 for every bobcat, and every unlicensed dog in areas frequented by deer, which is killed within the State, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2901, amended.** The first paragraph of section 2901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes under the caption "Claimant's Certificate", as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

To the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game:

I hereby certify that on the ..... day of ..... A.D., 19.... at ..... in the State of Maine, I killed the bobcat or dog, the skin of which I now exhibit to you, and I claim the bounty allowed by law for killing the same.

**Sec. 3. R. S., T. 12, § 2901, amended.** The first paragraph of section 2901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes under the caption "DEPARTMENT OF INLAND FISHERIES AND GAME", as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Augusta, Maine, ..... 19....

I hereby certify that I have received from ....., claimant,  
the tail of the bobcat or dog described in the foregoing certificate.

For Inland Fish and Game Commissioner

Note—Claim for bounty must be made within 10 days after the killing of the  
animal.
