AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the salaries of the county officers of Knox County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Knox County: County commissioners, $\$_{7,650}$ \$1,732.50; clerk of courts, $\$_{5,500}$ \$6,050; county attorney, \$7,500; county treasurer, $\$_{7,755}$ \$2,055; sheriff, $\$_{5,660}$ \$6,226; register of deeds, $\$_{5,660}$ \$6,226; judge of probate, $\$_{5,660}$ \$6,000; register of probate, \$4,000;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow for increases due to higher costs of living and to bring salaries more into line with existing conditions.
