Further amend said Bill in the 5th line of that part designated "<u>§2311.</u>" (4th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "full-time" the following underlined word 'undergraduates,'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 3 before the Statement of Fact the following: 'The breakdown shall be as follows:
