SENATE AMENDMENT to H.P. 927, L.D. 1225, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing a State Tuition Equalization Fund for Maine Students
Attending Maine Private Institutions of Higher Education."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line of that part designated
"§2311." (4th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined
word "attending" the following underlined word 'as'

Further amend said Bill in the 5th line of that part designated
"§2311." (4th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word
"full-time" the following underlined word and punctuation 'undergraduate'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. In order to provide for necessary
expenditures to carry out this program, there is appropriated from
the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of
Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$200,000 for the fiscal
year ending June 30, 1974 and the sum of \$300,000 for the fiscal
year ending June 30, 1975. The breakdown shall be as follows:
