STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Financial Reports of School Superintendents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 20, § 161, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 161 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 4. Shall keep account of finances and report once a term to committee of respective towns. He shall keep a faithful and accurate account of school finances, and he shall report at least once a term in writing to each of the several committees or directors, including in such report a statement of the condition of the schools, a financial statement containing a record of all financial transactions of the school during the last complete fiscal school year, including a complete itemized list of receipts and disbursements indicating to whom and for what purpose each amount was paid and a statement of the condition of school buildings and outbuildings in the matter of repair, cleanliness and sanitary arrangements.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to supply information to the several committees or directors in sufficient detail to allow them to knowledgeably and adequately make decisions involving finances of the school.
