HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 930, L. D. 1227 Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Prohibition of the Advertising of Drug
Prices."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 32, c. 73, additional. Title 32 of the Revised
Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter 73 to read as
follows:

CHAPTER 73

GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 4901. Powers of boards and commissions

Every board and commission established under this Title
shall have power:

1. Rules and regulations. To make such rules and
regulations as may be necessary for the regulation and practice
of such occupation or profession and the lawful performance of
its duties but which are neither inconsistent with the laws of
the State nor prohibit or unreasonably restrict the advertising
of price of any product, fee or service.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to remove the prohibition
of advertising in such professions as doctor, lawyer, optometrist,
pharmacist and physician.
