AN ACT Relating to Licenses to Carry Weapons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2031, amended. The 5th and 7th sentences of section 2031 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

All licenses shall continue in effect ~~to the end of the calendar year in which issued and for one year thereafter unless sooner~~ unless revoked by the Chief of the Maine State Police, chief of police, city marshal or by the selectmen of the town in which said license was issued.

Such record shall include date of issuance, the name, age, sex and street address of licensee, together with complete description of ~~weapon, and in case of firearms, the caliber, make and number~~ licensee and said description shall be placed on said certificate.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is:

1. Have the license continue in effect unless revoked; and
2. Have a description of the licensee on the record.
