## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting all Livestock and Poultry from the Personal Property Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 655, sub-§ 1, ¶ C, repealed and replaced. Paragraph C of subsection 1 of section 655 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 96 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
  - C. Mules and horses, including colts, neat cattle, sheep, lambs, swine, domestic fowl and goats.
