COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 949, L. D. 1246, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Motorcycle or Motor Driven Cycle Learner's  
Permit."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting  
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 29, § 532, amended. The first sentence of  
section 532 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed  
and replaced by section 24 of chapter 360 of the public laws of  
1971, is amended to read as follows:

Any person, ~~holding a valid driver's license and~~ who is at least  
16 years of age, may make application to the Secretary of State  
for a motorcycle or motor driven cycle learner's permit to  
operate a motorcycle or motor driven cycle, provided the requirements  
of section 583 have been met.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the requirement  
of a driver's license prior to issuance of a motorcycle or motor  
driven cycle learner's permit.
