RESOLVE, Providing for a Pension for Mrs. Gertrude Johnson of Lewiston.

Mrs. Gertrude Johnson; pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$100 per month be granted to Mrs. Gertrude Johnson to be paid monthly as a special legislative pension.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Resolve is to provide a modest pension for Mrs. Thomas (Gertrude) Johnson, widow of former Lewiston Police Chief, Thomas E. Johnson, who died in 1948 after having served 9 years with the Lewiston Police Department. Mrs. Johnson is not eligible for municipal pension under these facts.
