SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 956, L.D. 1266, Bill, "AN ACT Providing Funds for Psychiatric Aides at Pineland Hospital and Training Center."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:
