AN ACT Exempting Maine Guides from Boat Operator's License Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 236, sub-§ 2, ¶ F, additional. Subsection 2 of section 236 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph F, to read as follows:

F. This requirement shall not apply to the holder of a valid Maine guide's license.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this change is to exempt Maine guides from having to obtain a boat operator's license.
