STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the salaries of the county officers of Kennebec County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Kennebec County: County commissioners, \$3,200; chairman, \$3,500; clerk of courts, \$6,275 \$7,500; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,895; county attorney, \$9,-000; assistant county attorney, \$6,000; county treasurer, \$5,000; sheriff, \$7,-5e0 \$8,000; register of deeds, \$7,000 \$7,500; judge of probate, \$7,500 \$8,000; register of probate, \$7,500;

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 7, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 7 to read as follows:

§ 7. Kennebec County, deputy clerk of courts

The salary of the deputy clerk of courts of Kennebec County shall be set and determined by the county commissioners.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow salary increases for certain elected officials in Kennebec County and take the deputy clerk of courts salary out of section 2 of Title 30.
