AN ACT to Change the Term of Office of the Board of Barbers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 351, amended. The 3rd and 4th sentences of section 351 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The tenure of each barber member of the board shall be for 2 years. No barber shall serve more than 2 terms on the board. Each member shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council, and shall serve until his successor is appointed and qualified.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the opportunities for barbers to serve on the State Board of Barbers.
