COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 980, L. D. 1294, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Persons to Act as Policemen  
on Property of the Vocational-Technical Institutes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined  
paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'The State Board of Education may be authorized to establish  
guidelines within which each vocational-technical institute  
director may make rules and regulations for the control, movement  
and parking of vehicles within the limits of the property owned  
by or under the control of the Maine vocational-technical  
institutes. Such rules and regulations shall have the same  
force and effect as municipal ordinances and District Courts  
are authorized to impose fines not to exceed \$10 for each  
violation. The State Board of Education may adopt the provisions  
of Title 30, section 2151, subsection 3, paragraph A, relating  
to prima facie evidence and the establishment of a waiver of  
court action by payment of specified fees.'

Statement of Fact

In view of the provision of Title 20, section 51, ~~subsection~~ 3  
that grants to the State Board of Education the authority and  
duty to "establish, maintain and operate state technical and  
vocational institutes," this amendment gives supervisory authority  
to the State Board of Education for the making of rules and  
regulations for the control, movement and parking of vehicles  
at the Maine vocational-technical institutes.
