STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Persons to Act as Policemen on Property of the Vocational-Technical Institutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 2362, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2362, to read as follows:

§ 2362. Policemen at vocational-technical institutes

The directors of the Maine vocational-technical institutes may appoint persons to act as policemen who shall, within the limits of the property owned by or under the control of the Maine vocational-technical institutes, possess all of the powers of policemen in criminal cases.

The directors may make rules and regulations for the control, movement and parking of vehicles within the limits of the property owned by or under the control of the Maine vocational-technical institutes. Such rules and regulations shall have the same force and effect as municipal ordinances and District Courts are authorized to impose fines not to exceed \$10 for each violation. The directors may adopt the provisions of the Revised Statutes, Title 30, section 2151, subsection 3, paragraph A, relating to prima facie evidence and the establishment of a waiver of court action by payment of specified fees.
