STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for a Public Grain Storage Elevator.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000,000 to the Department of Transportation to locate, lay out, construct and maintain a public storage elevator for grain. Any balance of this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account for the same purpose until June 30, 1975.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title and provides \$1,000,000 therefor.
