STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Exempt Maine Home Health Service Agencies from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 16-A, additional. Section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 16-A to read as follows:

16-A. Home health service agencies. Sales to Maine's home health service agencies, certified by the Social Security Administration to provide medicaid and medicare benefits to Maine people.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that the loss of revenue will approximate \$1,500 for a full year.
