STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Joint Standing Committee Clerks under State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1001, sub-§ 10, amended. Subsection 10 of section 1001 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

"Employee" shall also mean clerks to the Joint Standing Committees of the Legislature, and such clerks shall receive creditable service for each year.

Sec. 2. Application. This Act shall not be retroactive but shall apply only to the committee clerks of the 106th Legislature and any future Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to permit legislative committee clerks to be employees under the Retirement System.
