COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 983, L.D. 1303, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Provide a Minimum Fine for Obstructing Justice."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact  
a new sentence to read as follows:

'The court may further order that restitution be made for damage to the  
property of a law enforcement officer resulting from any act or acts  
that have been found to be in violation of this section.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the court may  
order that restitution be made for damages to the property of a law  
enforcement officer resulting from a violation of Title 17, section 2952.
