COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 983, L.D. 1303, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide a Minimum Fine for Obstructing Justice."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact a new sentence to read as follows:

'The court may further order that restitution be made for damage to the property of a law enforcement officer resulting from any act or acts that have been found to be in violation of this section.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the court may order that restitution be made for damages to the property of a law enforcement officer resulting from a violation of Title 17, section 2952.
