COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 986, L.D. 1306, Bill, "AN ACT Prohibiting Bringing Animals Into Food Stores."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact, the following underlined sentence: 'This section shall not apply to any person requiring the services of a seeing-eye dog.'
