**AN ACT Prohibiting Bringing Animals Into Food Stores**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3965, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3965 to read as follows:

**§ 3965. Animals in food stores**

**It is unlawful for any person, other than the owner or manager, to bring any animal into a store where food is sold for human consumption.**
