### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Harvey H. McNally of Sherman Station.

Harvey H. McNally; reimbursed. Resolved: That notwithstanding the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 2952, or any other provision of law, there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Harvey H. McNally of Sherman Station the sum of \$1,500 for damages to his motor vehicle which is a result of colliding with a moose on Interstate 95 during the summer of 1971.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Resolve to permit Mr. McNally of Sherman Station to recover damages to his motor vehicle as a result of a moose on the Maine highway.
