STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Credit for Merchant Marine Service
Under Retirement Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1094, sub-§ 13, amended. Subsection 13 of section 1094 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

Military service under this subsection shall include merchant marine service.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit state employees to purchase prior credit under the Retirement System for war service in the merchant marine.
