HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1010, L.D. 1324, Bill "AN ACT Permitting a Dollar Check-off on Income Tax Returns for Election Campaign Fund."

Amend said Bill in section 1411 by inserting in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) after the underlined word "liability" the following underlined words: 'or refund'

Further amend said bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "§ 5283." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 5283. Designation by individuals

Every resident individual, whose income tax liability or refund for any taxable year is \$1 or more may designate that \$1 shall be paid into the Maine Election Campaign Fund, which is hereby established.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that refunds on an individual's income tax is covered by the bill and to clarify what tax payers may designate to check off.
