**AN ACT Exempting Sales to Inmates from Canteens in
State Institutions from the Sales Tax.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 3-A, additional. Section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 3-A to read as follows:

3-A. State institutions' canteens. Sales to inmates of state institutions from canteens located at such state institutions.

FISCAL NOTE

The loss of revenue will be approximately \$5,000 per year.
