HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1001, L. D. 1326, RESOLUTION,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Providing for Early  
Inauguration of the Governor.

Amend said Resolution by inserting before the paragraph,  
"form of question," the following:

'Effective date. Resolved: That the amendments herein proposed,  
if adopted, shall become effective on the first Wednesday of  
January, 1976.'
